News from our parish

Parish Council

The Annual Parish Assembly is quickly approaching on Sunday, February 11, 2018. There will be a lunch served after the Divine Liturgy and the meeting will begin at 1:00 p.m. If you are a member whose annual dues have been paid on or before December 31, 2017, please plan to attend this meeting. If you are a new member, six (6) months must have lapsed between the date of your membership and February 11, in order to vote at the Assembly.

This Assembly will be electing six new Parish Council members which is over half of the council. The outgoing council members are: Dn. Steve Adams, Dn. Dr. Varouj Aldebarmakian, Mark Der Matoian and Ben Krikorian all of whom have served four years and are termed out. In addition, Isabel Chilpighian and Robert Hancer have chosen not to run for a second term.

The financial reports for the past year are being completed and will reflect an operating deficit for the year of approximately \$12,000. We planned and budgeted for a \$22,000 deficit and the results ended up more favorable, due to some unanticipated increases in hall rental income and a bequest to the church. Notwithstanding the deficit, we had a positive cash flow because our expenses included \$22,000 in Diocesan Dues which we could not pay. We have had discussions with the Diocesan Council to come up with

some solutions to the way dues are assessed to our parish and our inability to pay \$34,000 per year.

There will be a discussion on the bathroom project the Parish Council is currently working on. A committee has been appointed and plans are being prepared for renovation of the two bathrooms in the Berberian Hall. In addition, the roof and solar projects (which were completed last year) will be open for any discussion under old business.

Our Endowment Fund will be a discussion topic to provide information on how it operates and how parishioners can set up a permanent endowment for the benefit of our church.

You have received your Annual Detailed Statement of your contributions for 2017, which you should retain with your income tax records. Please call the office if you find any differences between your records and ours.

The Parish Council welcomes six new members: Ishkhan and Arda Bayrakdarian, Charles and Debra Garabedian and Jeffrey and Erin (Bohigian) Moore.
