Junior ACYO

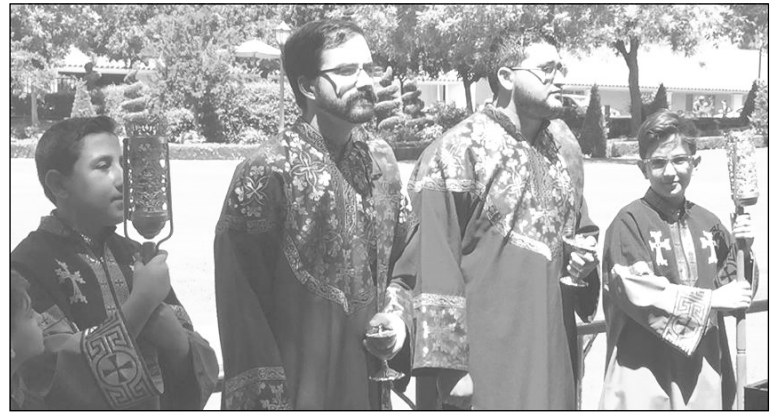
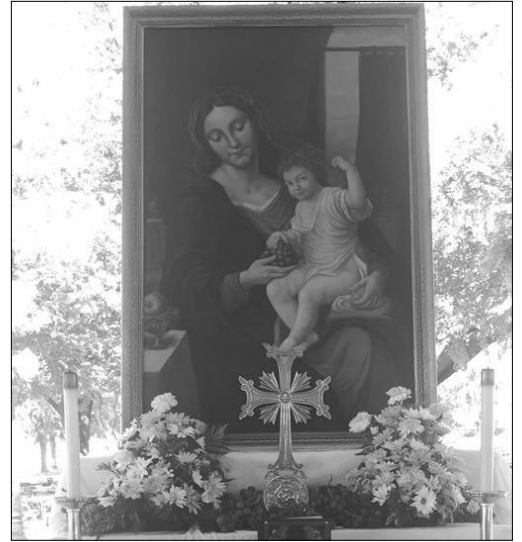

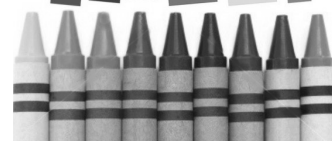

Friday, July 20, Young Adult Activity Update

Fr. Yessai, with his devotional message, spoke about Spirituality and the Bible, the word of God, which he explained, stands for “Basic Instructions before Leaving Earth”. Each Young Adult expressed wisely their own version about spirituality. Fr.

Yessai talked about knowing God, through reading the Bible daily as a guide for our Christian life to continually feel connected to our Almighty.

The Young Adults’ Committee prepared a delicious BBQ tri-tip meal. Over 100 FSU football players and coaches were fed. All of us had a great time talking with many of them and getting to know them better.

Bob Der Matoian purchased everything needed. He had everything ready to go and labeled when the committee arrived to cook. The Pilaf/Salad Crew (which consisted of Jerry Mootafian and Bob Der Matoian) began cooking at 1:45 p.m. They were soon joined by Mark Der Matoian, Duke Frazier, ‘Honorary Hye’ Bill Steel, Mike Chardukian, Jonathon Chardukian and Parish Council Chairman, Jeff Markarian. As everyone sat around waiting for the pilaf to cook, ice cold water was shared followed by preparing the green beans and cooking 165 lbs. of chicken. The Bar-B-Ques were going full blast (as was the heat) but everything was cooked, loaded up, and to Fresno State by 5:45 p.m. The remaining crew members joined the group at Fresno State. Sue Der Matoian arrived with 174 home baked triple cookie sandwiches. The fabulous cookies and delicious fruit Duke brought made for some fantastic dessert! Janet Sabbatini, Mike Der Matoian, Paula Der Matoian, Perry Mamigonian and Suzy Mamigonian rounded out the set-up and serving crew. A few of the regulars could not make it this year and were missed, but the rest picked up the slack and got everything done.

By 6:00 p.m. the food was ready to serve as the team came in. Coach Tedford wants his team to really be a team, to the point of sharing all meals together during pre-season camp. He has a hard rule of no phones during dinner. Coach Tedford told everyone that getting to know the people of this community is an important part of bringing them together. St. Paul is the only community group providing this service to Coach Tedford and the team and while there’s hope others will follow suit and do the same, St. Paul will continue to feed these teams and make sure they know who Armenians are. Of course, it’s also important that they know that St.

Paul Armenian Church has the best pilaf in Fresno!

After all the hard work of preparing for and serving the team (and providing a lot of second servings) the committee sat down with them and enjoyed the fruits of their labor. A huge thank you to everyone who helped, especially to Bob for his generous donation of all that pilaf!
