## *Parish Council*

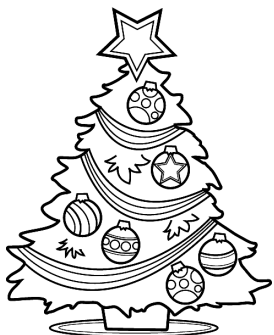
The Parish Council wishes you a Happy New Year and a healthy, prosperous 2020!

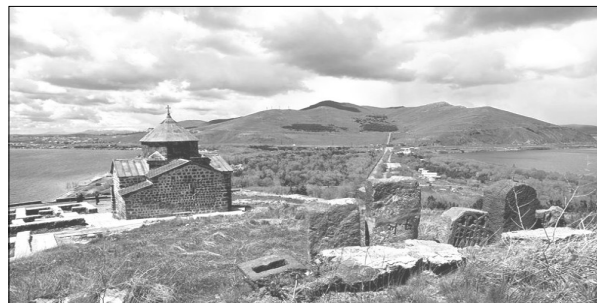

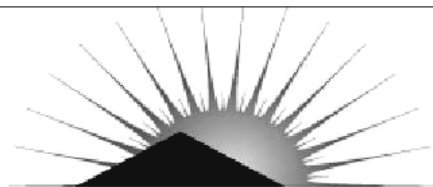

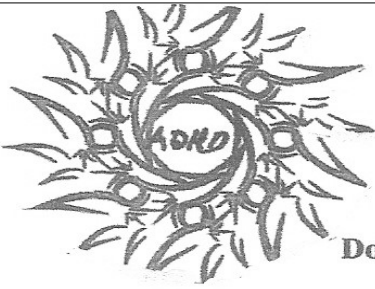
